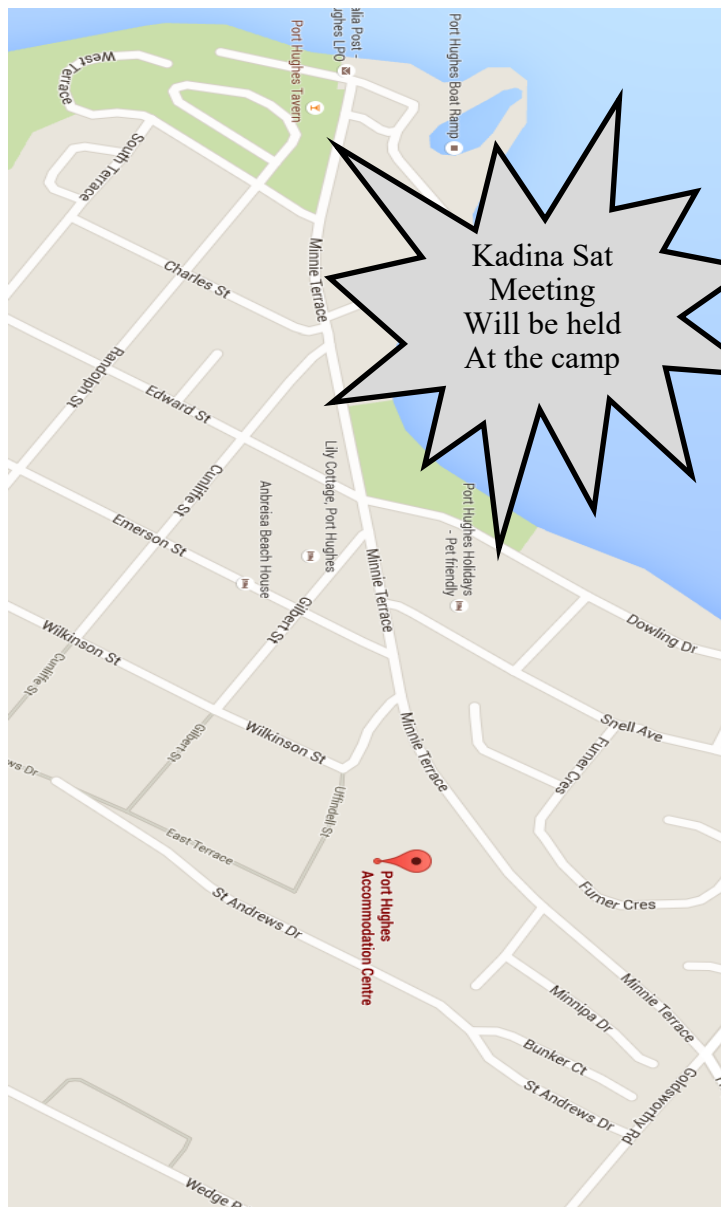

## Onsite activities

The centre is situated on about 2 hectares of land and has a large grassed area enclosed by buildings on 3 sides. This is suitable for all kinds of ball games. With no overhead power lines, kite flying can be enjoyed.

There is also a large activities shed with space for indoor sports such as volleyball, badminton and table tennis, making it ideal in very hot or cold, rainy weather. A basketball/tennis court can be used both day and night



### Activities in the surrounding area

Moonta is about 4 kilometres from Pt Hughes and, with Kadina and Wallaroo, had a flourishing mining industry in the 19th and early 20th centuries and there are many reminders of this in the area. The Moonta Mines historical area has a museum and tourist train which takes visitors through the mines area.

Wheal Hughes mine at North Moonta has opened an underground area for visitors, and, the coastal towns are popular for swimming, sailing and fishing. (especially for whiting).

The region holds a Cornish Festival – Kernewek Lowender – every two years to celebrate the area's links with Cornwall, England. Many miners emigrated to this area to work in the copper mines.
